Did You Know?



- **PEI is the only province that does not FULLY exempt the RDSP**
- **The Government of Canada allows \$7,239 as the base amount for non-refundable Disability Tax Credit to eligible Canadians while the Province of PEI allows \$6,890 for the same credit eligible to Islanders.**
- **We as family and friends of people with disabilities cannot leave money in our wills to our sons and daughters with disabilities without them losing their daily supports and services.**
- **PEI is one of the last provinces in Canada that still does not have Supported Decision Making Legislation.**

We must, do better than this. Will you stand up for our sons and daughters and change well-known systems of poverty, welfare and exclusion? We, people with disabilities, their families and their friends live in your riding. We ARE your constituents, your voters. Our issues are your issues.

Our questions are simple:

- 1. Will you immediately catch PEI up with the rest of Canada and fully exempt the RDSP?**
- 2. Will the Province of PEI amend the PEI Tax Act to bring Disability Tax Credit (DTC) in line with the Federal Income Tax Act with respect to base amounts?**
- 3. Will you provide the necessary leadership and ensure the ascension of Support Trust Legislation so we can leave money in our wills to our without them being cut off from daily supports and services?**
- 4. Will you provide the necessary leadership and ensure the ascension of Supported Decision Making Legislation so our friends or family members don't end up under the Public Guardian, but rather supported through family, friends and our community?**
